





We sang one of Anne’s own songs “The star comes down, the lights turned off, the tinsel taken down from the tree. Put Christmas firmly in its box, there’s nothing left for us to see”.

Steve King led again on 11th January bringing us two secular songs “Pack of cards” and “On the first day of Christmas”. But Steve then explained the hidden biblical meanings behind these songs.

Penny Bloom and Bob Pearson came to us on January 18th with the theme “You brought me to his banqueting table. With a reading from Song of Songs “He brought me to his banqueting hall” and the song “He brought me to his banqueting table”, Penny set up a banqueting table with many items representing love, joy, hope and peace. Bob led several songs on his guitar and we also played two of his videos “My peace I give unto you” and “May the grace of Jesus”.
